



SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA CHAPTER 2005 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Urban Financial Services Coalition San Francisco Bay Area Chapter is pleased to announce its 2004 Scholarship Award Program. This program is designed to select and provide scholarship awards to minority students interested in pursuing an undergraduate degree with a business or finance related emphasis and have been accepted to a four-year university or college.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be considered in the selection process, students must:

- Be a resident of the Bay Area.
- Have earned a minimum of a 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) or "C+" grade point average. A transcript of grades must be included with application materials.
- Have an acceptable attendance and citizenship record. Verification from your school must be provided.
- Have a financial need based upon family income.
- Complete a scholarship application form.
- Provide a one-page, typed essay on the topic, **"If you were elected President of the United States this November, what would be your first order of business once in office?"** Essays longer than one page will not be considered.
- Provide three letters of recommendation from the school principal, counselor, teacher, minister, or other responsible adult not related to the applicant.
- If available, provide a copy of an acceptance letter or statement of intent to register at a four-year college or university.

Complete application packets must be received or postmarked by April 15, 2004. Incomplete applications will be not considered. Please mail applications with all supporting documents to:
